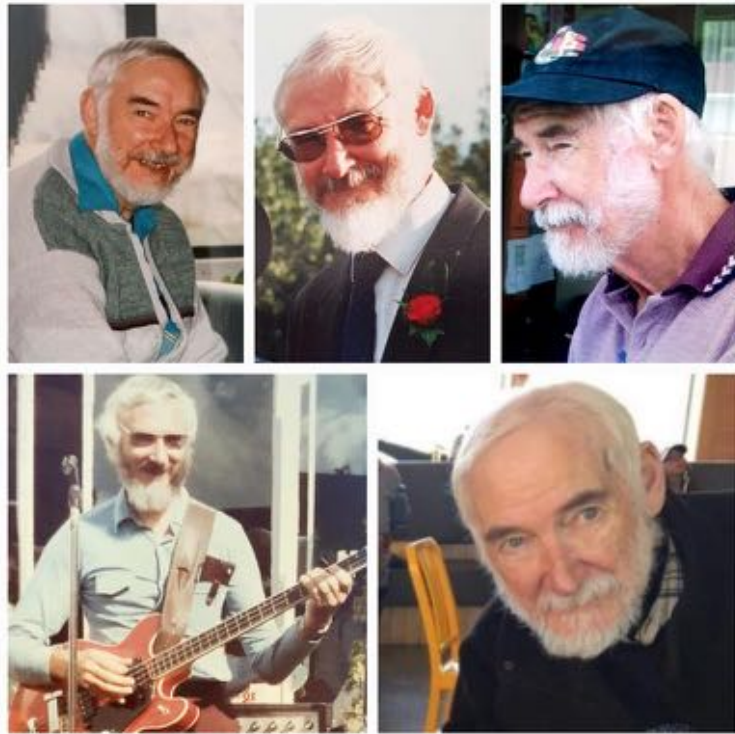
Adieu to Gerry Clark, well-known Waikato “musician, teacher and friend to many”
